

A group of staff then comes together to deliberate over the issue. Supported by MosaicLab facilitators, they agree on a set of recommendations and write a report which they hand over to key, internal decision-makers.

This condensed version of a deliberative process (modelled on a real citizens' jury or people's panel) allows your staff to build their capacity through participation. WHAT IS IT?

The Deliberative Democracy Masterclass is an immersive training experience that takes participants on a journey through a citizens' assembly, and gives those looking to facilitate deliberations the chance to unpack the facilitation methods and processes.

The idea for the masterclass sprang from the development of the Big Book - 'Facilitating Deliberation – A Practical Guide'.

WHO IS IT FOR?

The Deliberative Democracy Masterclass is made up of two modules, each created for a particular audience:

GROUP A: Community engagement practitioners, facilitators, elected members, decision-makers and anyone who is interested in finding out more about how deliberative democracy works.

GROUP B: Facilitators who want to learn how to run citizens' assemblies

HOW DOES IT WORK?

BOOK ONE MODULE OR BOTH, DEPENDING ON YOUR NEEDS:

Module One: two-day immersive assembly. This module is for Group A (above) and works like a condensed citizens' assembly, exploring a question many facilitators may find relevant to their day jobs.

At the same time, it will be a training event for six to eight facilitators learning how the process works. This means those attending will also get an inside look at how facilitation works in practice.

Module Two: three-day facilitation focus. This module is for Group B and unpacks the facilitation skills and techniques for facilitators who want to become masters in this form of engagement.

This experience will step through each method and process, helping participants to understand the purpose behind each one, see different variations of each method and practice the approaches.

- Better understand what it would be like for you, your organisation and your communities when you undertake a deliberative process.
